This detached barn conversion is set in open countryside alongside its companion property (next door barn conversion) and a white farmhouse. It has views down to the mountain, across fields to the sea. It overlooks a 15th century church which can be accessed a short distance across the 5 acre field belonging to the property.

It has a large garden, a tennis court and across a small bridge there is a large pond that is filled by a small stream which runs through the garden (dry for approx 2 months in summer). The pond is surrounded by fir trees. It is located halfway up Mynydd Bodafon Mountain in an area of outstanding natural Beauty and unspoilt countryside.
