Interior

Interior spaces are decorated in a carefully chosen palette of calm pale neutrals that showcase the original architectural details and the abundance of natural light. A fully working pipe organ and original horseshoe gallery remain. Two large painted bespoke wooden double gates opening onto limestone steps flanked by 2 victorian gothic lanterns - both working. Italianate style portico with pink marble granite pillars leading to a grand pair of large natural antique wood double doors. Light filled space with soaring ceilings, antique brass opaline pendant lights and two pairs of magnificent antique wooden doors. Two light filled, carved wood winding staircases each side lead to the upper seating gallery with original numbered pine pews. WC Plant filled, bright sunny spaces. Carved wood staircases and wooden floors lead up to the horseshoe seating gallery. Dining area has a huge antique mahogany dining table and chairs that seats 12+ Decorative cast iron columns. BASEMENT STUDIO SPACE with 2 x WC's 15.25m x 7m Deceptively spacious basement space. Open plan with 3.5m high ceilings. The space is accessed down stone steps at the front of the building. Recently converted to an artist studio and event space. The walls are painted a neutral white and the wooden floor is painted a mid taupe. 8 x antique white opaline globe ceiling lights Furnished with a mix of persian rugs and mid century modern furniture.

Exterior

A former Methodist Chapel within a stones throw of the beach and the sweeping views. The exterior boasts a grand covered portico with Italianate pink marble columns, original limestone steps, huge gothic lanterns and four magnificent antique carved wood doors. Within a residential area with parking all around 3 sides of the building and a public car park on street away.
