The Farmhouse The farmhouse and cottages accommodate 24 people in 12 double en-suited rooms, with some additional non en-suited rooms on request. The property originates in the 17th Century and has an abundance of features including:* old fireplaces* vaulted cellars* an old stone walls* magnificent farm kitchen* three reception rooms* an Orangery also offers very spacious living/working space* wood burning stoves* views from every window - offering a real touch of magic
