Interior

Detached period riverside property built in the Edwardian period, approx 1905. The house has been a family home since it was built and still has most of it's original features, including open fireplaces, wood panelling and light and airy rooms.

The ground floor comprises a large sitting room, a wood panelled dining room and a study - all of which have views down the river.

Upstairs there are 5 bedrooms on the 1st floor, all decorated in a similar style with a further 3 bedrooms on the 2nd floor with an under-eaves bedroom.

Exterior

- 3 storey, asymetric, Edwardian house with interesting features. It has a balcony to the front, accessed from the master bedroom, a large full storey offset bay with views down the river

- Driveway parking for 7+ cars and there is parking nearby for any overspill
