Interior

The main house has 59 bright rooms that have been extensively refurbished while retaining the original decorative ironwork, coloured glass and moulded ceilings. The south elevation is particularly impressive, with its fine terrace overlooking the rolling Surrey hills. The imposing reception area includes stunning rose-and-leaf windows by Charles Rennie Mackintosh, as well as a grand sweeping staircase and gallery.
