- large (railed) hole in the centre of venue 2, which looks down through the middle to the stage below on venue 1
- Two built in bars
- Seating
- Camera set up â€" live feed of performances below play on 8 screens

Venue 3

- 300 capacity
- Built in bar
- DJ boothThese venues are linked by stairs and corridors, and have visitor toilets, two smaller rooms and access to upper decks
