Interior

Originally a listed stable block, the space has been brought to life with an elegant yet understated design and provides a genuinely inspiring yet welcoming environment that perfectly transitions from morning to night.

It has been finished with bespoke items including a handmade staircase crafted in an old chapel near Stockport.

Original concrete floors, stable doors, brickwork and arches have been retained

White Victorian-style tiling is in keeping with the space, filled with grey grouting similar to that found on the London Underground, reminiscent of Victorian London

Curved edges run throughout, from bullnose tables to tan leather chairs, the shape of the bar and sofa seating

Glass conservatory flooded with natural light, open kitchen, marble topped island bar and large wine cellar.

Exterior

Large stable block with original brick walls, stable doors and curved arch windows. A beautiful glass conservatory is attached.

The venue is situated behind the main road in a peaceful new development.
